
COLOR PRINT BIGGER PIECES USING CARD STOCK (OR THICKER THAN REGULAR) PAPER

COLOR PRINT SMALLER PIECES (STAIRS, PIPE, ETC) AND INSTRUCTIONS USING REGULAR PAPER.


Cut carefully all pieces and fold and glue as shown:




FOLD "A" AS SHOWN




GLUE "A" INTO "B"




FOLD "B" AS SHOWN




FOLD AND GLUE "ROOF 1" as shown








GLUE "FLAP 1" ON PLACE,
