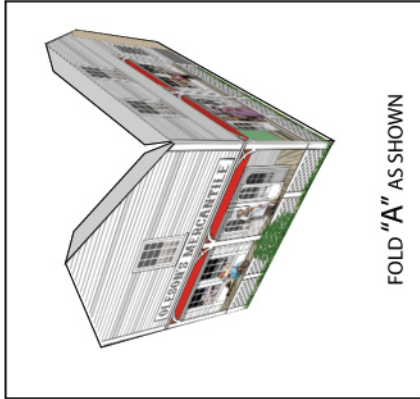




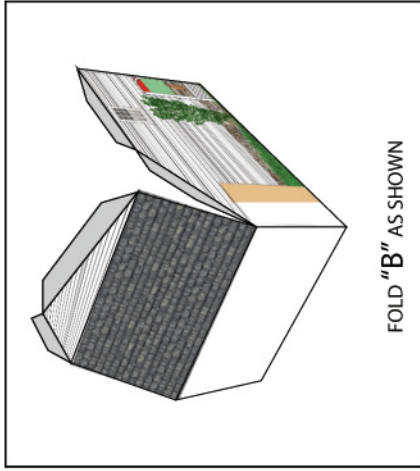
OLESON'S MERCANTILE MINIATURE MODEL INSTRUCTIONS

 COLOR PRINT SMALLER PIECES (STAIRS, PIPE, ETC) AND INSTRUCTIONS USING REGULAR PAPER.

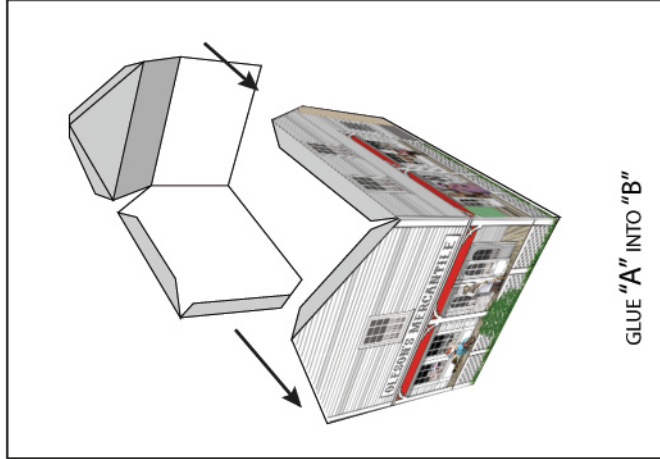
Cut carefully all pieces and fold and glue as shown:



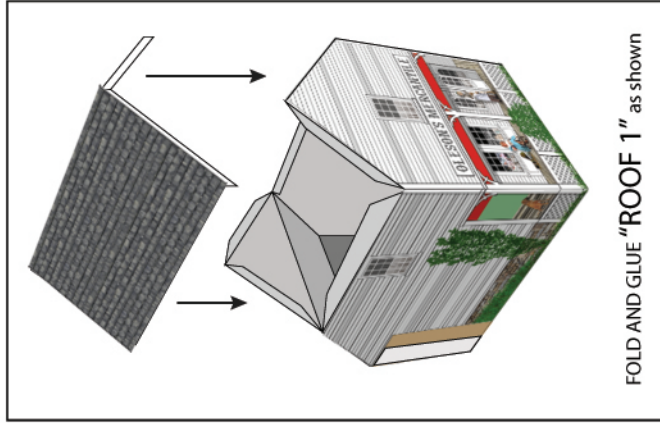
FOLD "A" AS SHOWN



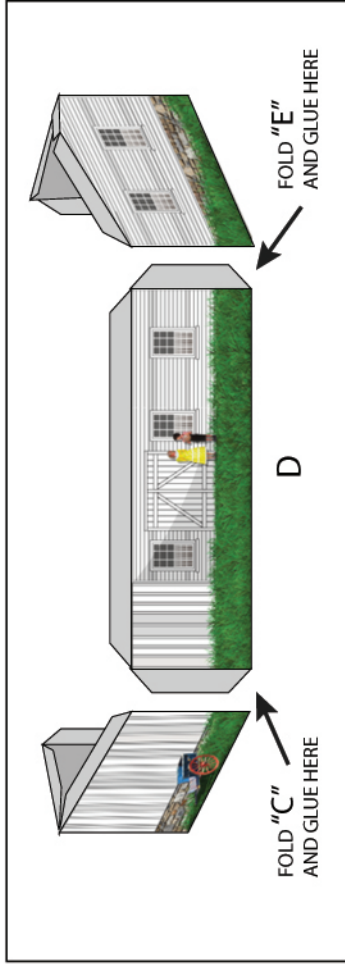
FOLD "B" AS SHOWN



GLUE "A" INTO "B"



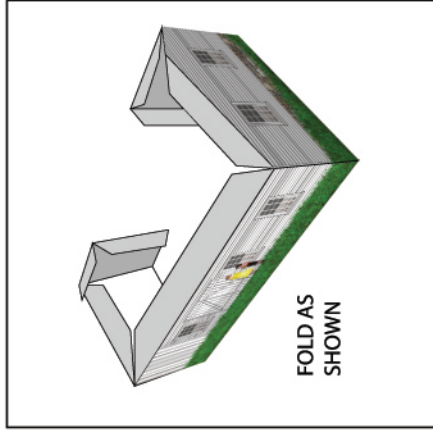
FOLD AND GLUE "ROOF 1" as shown



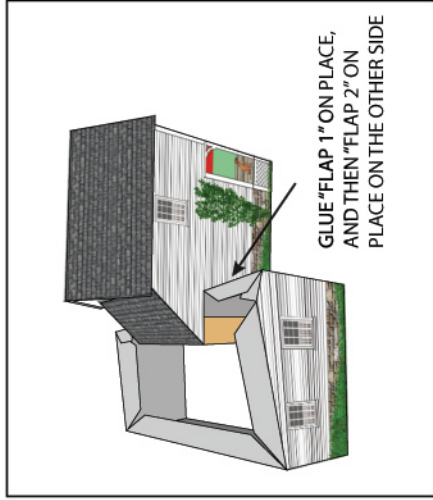
